The Organisers cannot be held responsible for emails that do not arrive due to the entrant's email security settings or restrictions placed by their Internet service provider.

All photographs must be entered via the Comfort & Joy Submission form on the St. Luke's website.

Photographs must be a minimum 1MB – maximum 10MB file

If your photograph features any person or people and they are clearly identifiable, they should be aware that they are being photographed and permission should be obtained from all involved (or their parent's/guardian's permission if under 16) for their photograph to be submitted.

St Luke's Prestonville reserves the right to remove or refuse any entries from the gallery for any reason.

Copyright and reproduction

You must be the sole author and owner of the copyright for all images entered. You will retain copyright of your entries at all times and always be credited alongside your picture.
