Little seeds grow into amazing plants of all kinds! God's words planted in you can grow into all sorts of wonderful things, too!




Activity: Growing Cress Seeds

This little pot will remind you how God's words are like seeds and that if you listen and are open to his words they will grow in you, just like the cress seeds will grow in the pot!








You will need an empty, clean yogurt pot, a label (see the template), sticky tape, kitchen roll and cotton wool. And some cress seeds and water, too!

- 1. Colour in your label and decorate it however you wish.
- 2. Cut it out and stick it to the outside of the pot using sticky tape.
- 3. Wet some kitchen roll and put it in the bottom of the pot.
- 4. Put the cotton wool in on top and add a little bit of water over it so it is damp, but not soggy!
- 5. Sprinkle some seeds onto the cotton wool.
- 6. Put the pot on a windowsill and occasionally add a little water if it's needed.
- 7. Watch those seeds grow!
