"³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd."


Matthew 10:

Painting on pebbles is fun. You can decorate a pebble in bright colours and then write a little message on it to give to a family member or friend. You could choose something kind to say that will cheer them up or make them feel better. Have a look at the stones in this picture.

You will need clean pebbles – wash and dry them thoroughly first. You can then paint on them, using water-based or acrylic paints. Keeping your colours clear and bright by painting several coats on and allow to dry. You can write your message on if it is

easier than painting, using a fine marker pen. Then varnish over the top if you can, to make it all last as long as possible. A lovely little gift to spread kindness!
