

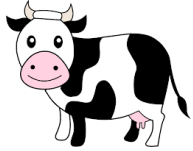

Did you know? Cattle eat hay and grass.

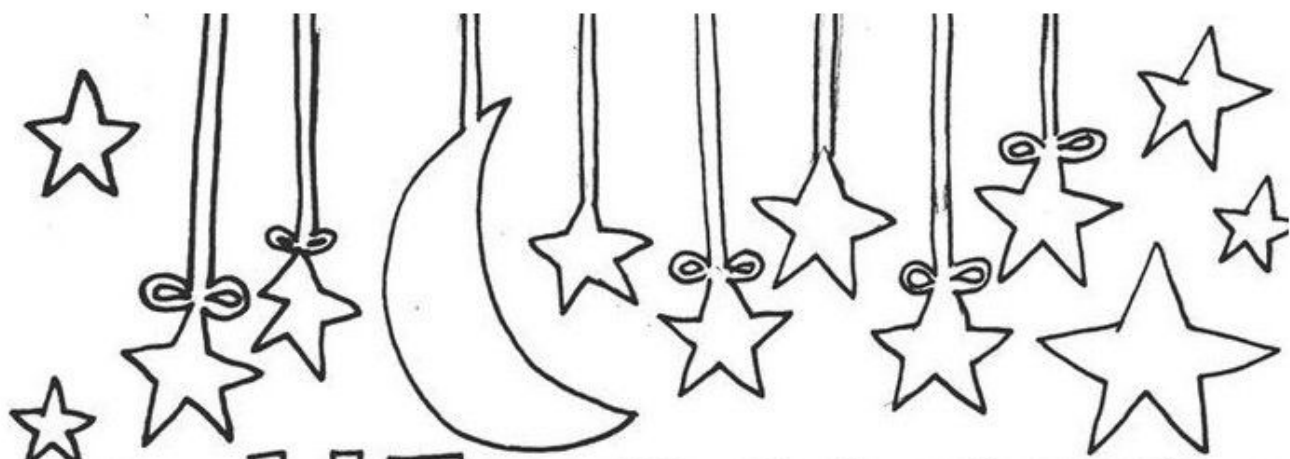
