




Children's Church – 23rd August Matthew 16: 13-20 Peter Declares Jesus to be the Messiah

Jesus asked his disciples who they thought he was. It was Peter who said, "You are the Messiah, the son of the living God". Jesus told him that he was blessed, because it was God who had told him that.

He said "You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church." He also said, "I will give you the keys to the kingdom of Heaven".





Peter recognised **Jesus** as the **Messiah** – this means the **Saviour**, or the **Chosen One**. He showed great understanding and faith!

Activity:

Dear Lord




Thank you for being our **Messiah**, our **King** and our **Saviour**. Please help us to be like Peter by seeing this every time we pray to you and speak to you.
