Craft: Make your own safe Advent Candle Wreath!

The lighting of an Advent Wreath is a custom that started in Germany over 400 years ago! There are four candles: three purple and one pink candle. In the centre sits a white candle. You may need some help to make this one, but it will be worth it!

First cut out a large circle of card. Then draw around your hand lots of times onto green card and cut them all out. You can then stick them around onto the card to create the base of the wreath.



Next, take four kitchen roll tubes. Cut four of them shorter than the fifth. Paint three of these purple and one pink. Paint the tall one white. Then paint the words onto them, or use stick-on letters: on the purple ones, write **PREPARE**, (or alternatively **PEACE**), **LOVE** and **HOPE**, one word on each. On the pink one, write **JOY**, and on the white one, write **CHRIST** (or **JESUS**). Ask a grown-up to stick them onto your base with a glue gun. Then scrunch up orange and yellow tissue paper to put into the top of the rolls as flames.
