Acts 2: The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Psalm 150

- ¹ Praise the LORD.ຟ Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens.
- ² Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness.
- ³ Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre,
- ⁴praise him with timbrel and dancing, praise him with the strings and pipe,
- ⁵ praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals.
- ⁶Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD.

Craft: Have some fun making beautiful flame shapes on paper. You just need orange, red and yellow paint (or any one of them), paper and a straw.

- 1. Thin the paint down with water.
- 2. Add blobs of the paint to the middle or bottom of the page.
- 3. Use a drinking straw to gently blow the paint out. Try to make it fan upwards and outwards to look like flickering flames!
