Think about how **YOU can show kindness** to other people. At this time of being at home so much, it's more important than ever to be kind to others.

1. Can you think of 3 kind things someone else has done for you?
2. Can you think of 3 kind things you have done for someone else?
3. And now – can you think of 3 kind things you could do for someone today?



Craft: Kindness Jar



1. Find an empty jar or pot. A see-through one is best.
2. Make a lovely label saying "Kindness Jar" and decorate it with lots of colours – you could also add stickers, pom-poms or glitter if you have some.
3. Cut a sheet of paper into strips big enough to write on and keep them next to the jar.
4. Each time you or someone in your home does something kind, write it down on one of the strips of paper. If you would rather not write it you could just draw a smiley face to represent the kindness.
5. Fold the piece of paper and pop it in the jar.
6. You can look at the jar to remind yourself to be kind to other people and to remember that **God's Kindness Jar is always full!**
