



Children's Church – Sunday 4th October Harvest Festival

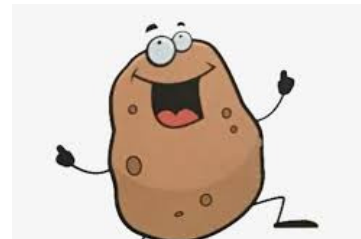

Craft: Wreath of Thanks

As we are thinking of all the things we want to say thank you for, let's make a lovely wreath to show this!





- First make a ring out of card so it is fairly strong.
- Then colour the leaf templates provided with these sheets and cut them out.
- On each one you can write something you are thankful for – such as your friends, your pet, favourite food, your brother or sister, etc.
- Then stick them around the ring. You could add a bow or any decoration of your choice at the bottom if you want.
- Add a loop of string to the back and then you can hang it up to remind you how lucky you are!



Prayer:

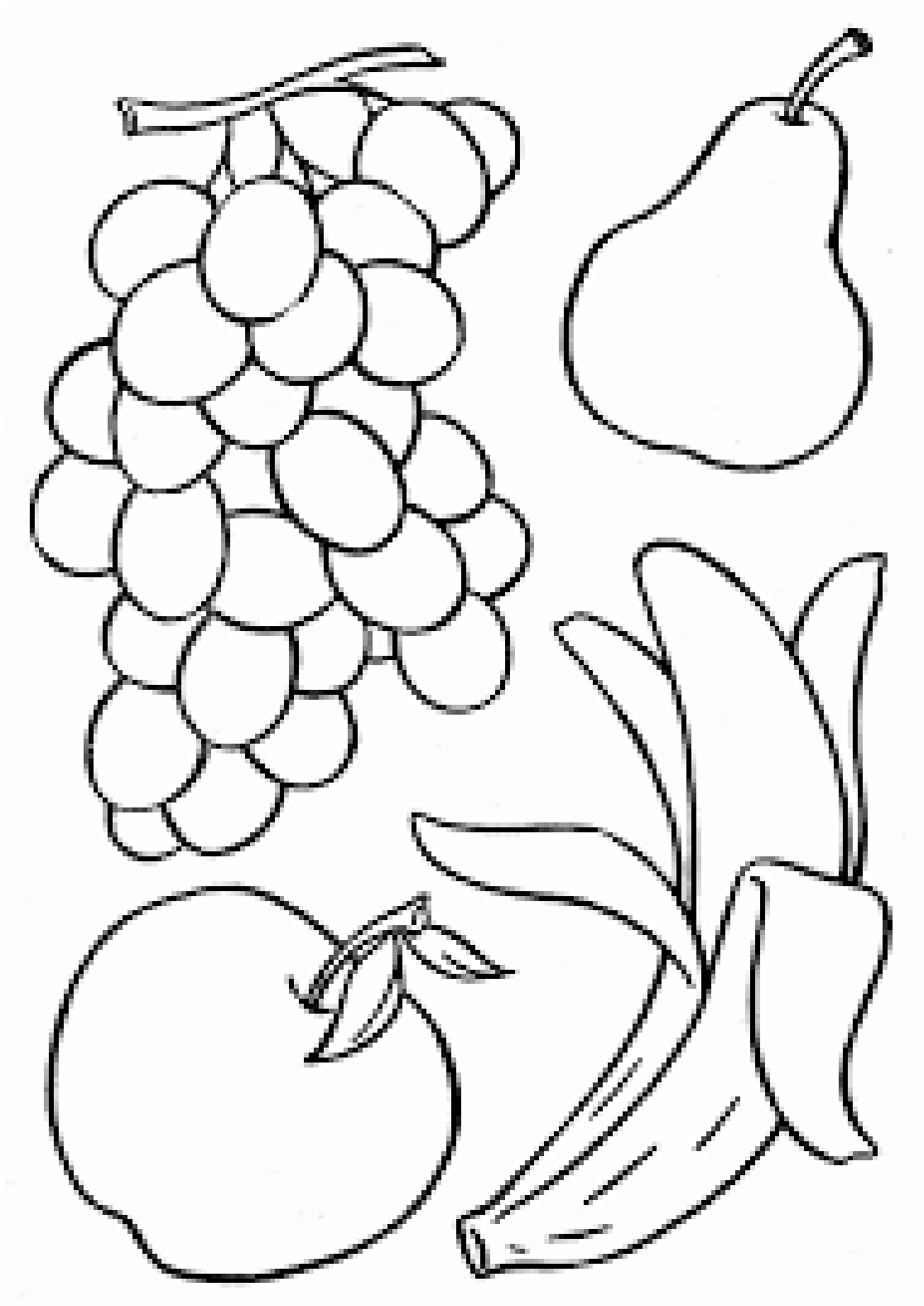
Dear Lord
