


Jesus was welcomed into Jerusalem by the people. He rode in on a donkey and the people threw their cloaks and palm leaves on the ground for him, treating him like a King. They were full of happiness and praise! **Palm Sunday** reminds of this day. Palms are large leaves that can be woven into all sorts of patterns and shapes. **Have a look at these:**



You can weave with paper, too! **Have a go at this week's craft to make a piece of weaving.** It can remind you of the palms that were laid at Jesus' feet as he rode into town on the donkey, and of the joy and happiness of the people at that time.

Weaving with Paper



1. Take a rectangle of paper or card and fold it in half lengthways
2. Cut in from the fold to about 2cm from the other edge. Do this along the fold with a gap of 2cm between cuts. Open out your card
3. Now cut your weaving paper into strips. You can use plain paper, painted paper or patterned – even newspaper!
4. Weave the first strip in and out on your “loom”

5. Weave the second strip in and out but go under and over in the opposite way to your first strip, like this:



6. You should end up with something like these!
