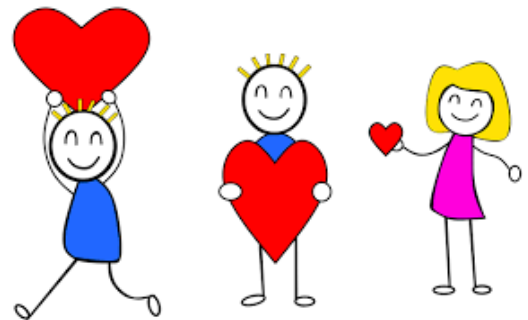




**Children's Church – Sunday 8th November**

## Craft: Plantable Poppies



I love the way these poppies have a future! The petals are made using two potato prints – half a potato dipped in red paint. Then sprinkle poppy seeds onto the middle of the of the flower while the paint is still wet. When Remembrance Day is over, the poppies can be cut out and planted in the ground so that they will grow into new poppies – a real symbol of hope for the future!

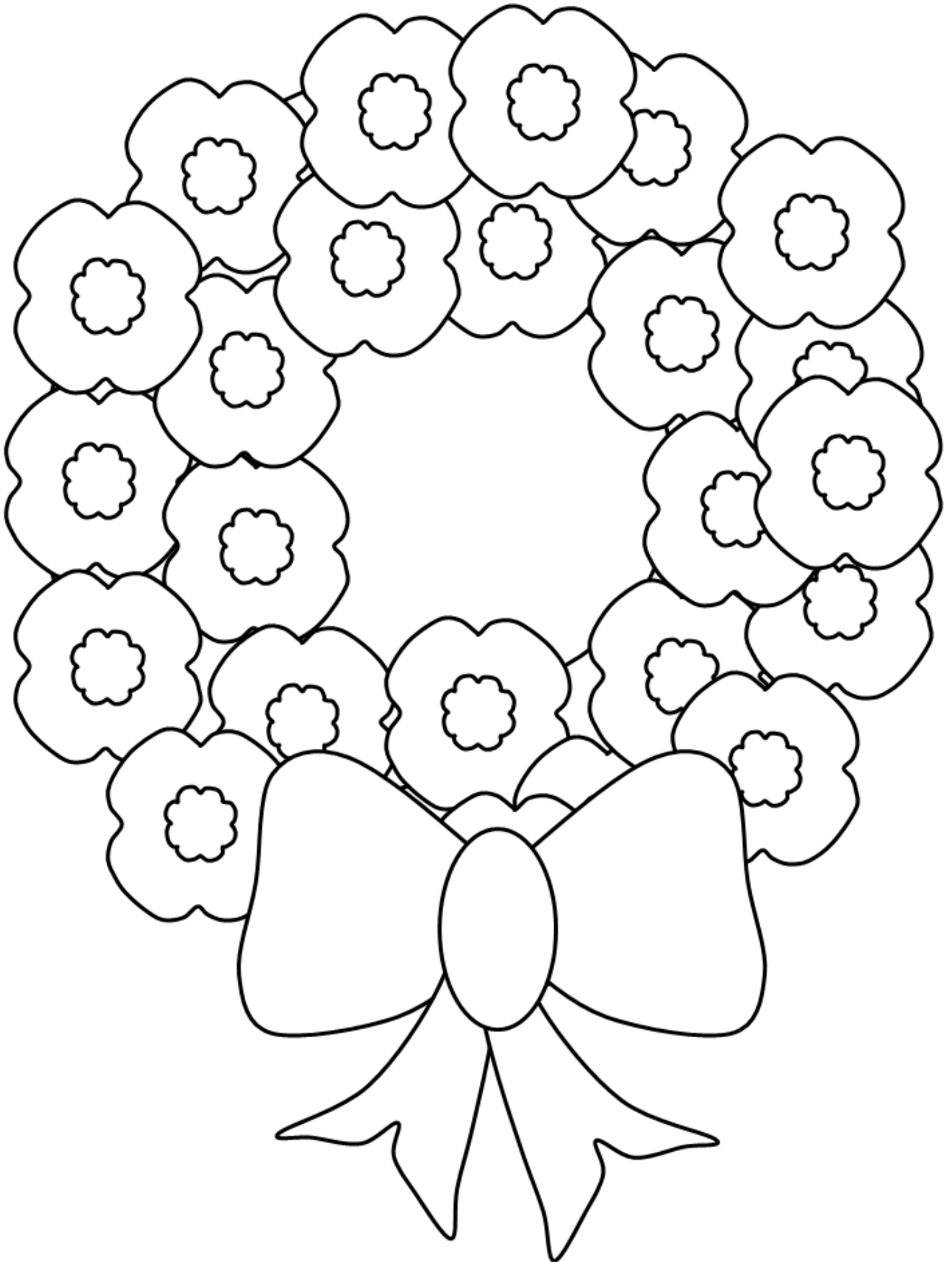
