### Leafy Fox

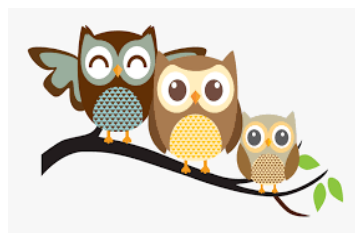


Collect some gorgeous autumn leaves from the ground to use for this. Take your time looking through them to find the best shape and colour to make this super face. Stick the leaf down onto your page and add googly eyes, black paper ears and nose and draw on some whiskers. What other animal faces could you make with leaves? Simple but fun!



This beautiful craft is made using leaves, too – this time, lots of the same kind. They are carefully overlapped onto a piece of card or paper to give the illusion of feathers and the mix of browns adds to the tawny effect. Great big eyes are stuck on and a beak and feet – and don't forget two leaves for the ears! There is an owl template with these sheets that you could use.

## Pinecone Hedgehogs



This sweet little family of hedgehogs is made of pinecones and felt. If your pinecones are damp they will be closed up, so you will need to put them on the windowsill to dry out and they will gradually open. Cut the faces out of felt – triangles with rounded edges. Add googly eyes and little black felt noses and then glue them to the top of the pinecones.



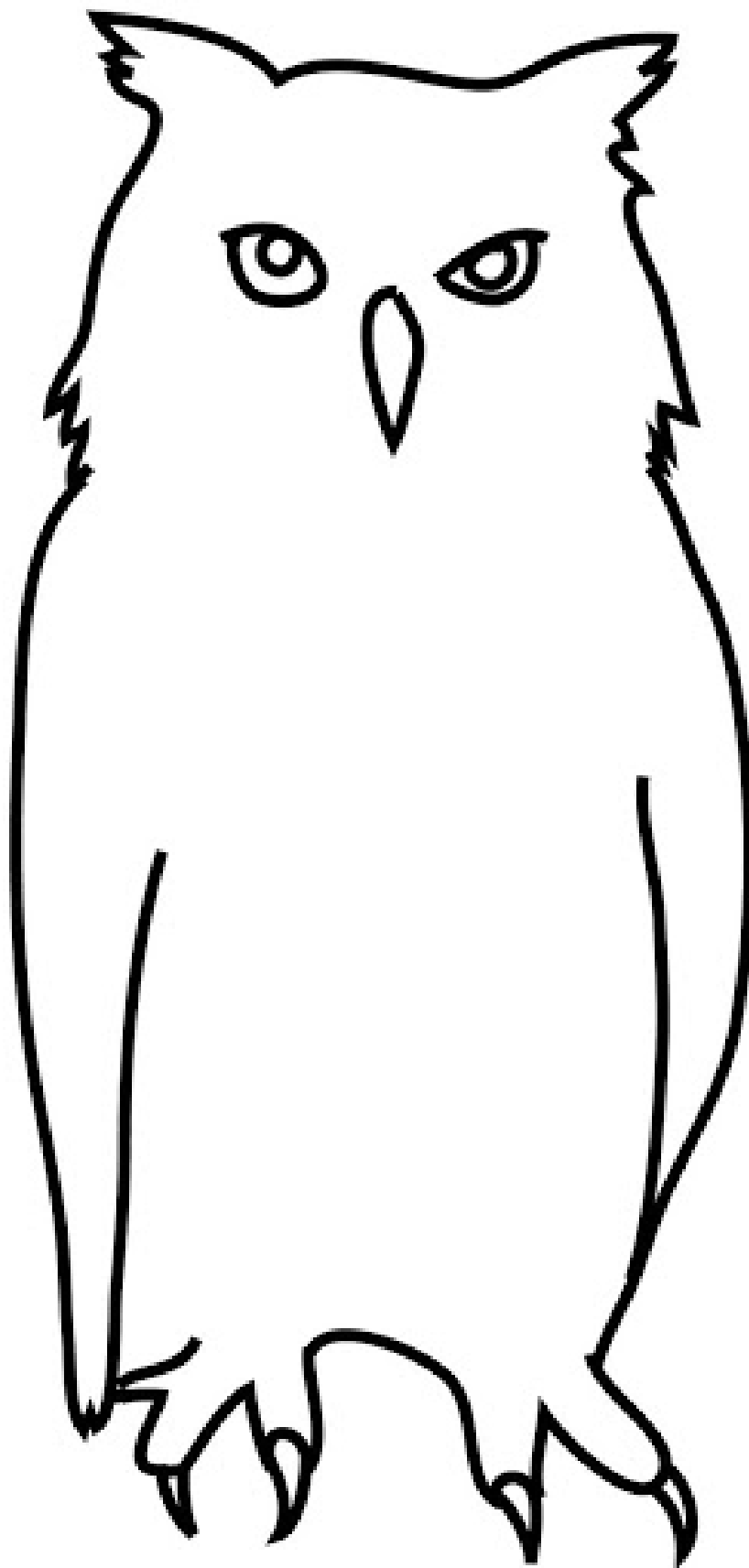
## Bushy-tailed Squirrel

Again using leaves, this squirrel tail is fabulous! Use lots of colours and stick them onto your squirrel, moving in an upwards and outwards pattern to make the tail perky! There is a squirrel template with these sheets if you would like to use that. The acorn is optional!!
