This week – SHEEP!

On Sunday we will be looking at a story that Jesus told about Sheep and Goats so we thought we'd give you some craft ideas to create your own artistic sheep using things that you've already got in the house and the template at the end of this sheet.

Textured Sheep



It's interesting to see how many different textures you could use to create different sheep but using the same template.



This one uses white bubble wrap to make the body of the sheep. You could do this using transparent bubble wrap which you could paint white or leave as it is.

The body of this sheep is made from shredded paper which you can collect from a shredder and stick on with some glue.



Of course sheep are woolly so you might want to make at least one out of cotton wool using cotton wool balls.

This one is a bit more abstract and is made from a plastic cup which you cut into little strips and then splay out to make the body shape. Cut down the side of the cup until you get to the bottom but leave the bottom intact. Once you've done this 10 – 15 times, turn the cup upside down and then flatten it and you can stick the sheep head onto the circular bottom.
