this week**

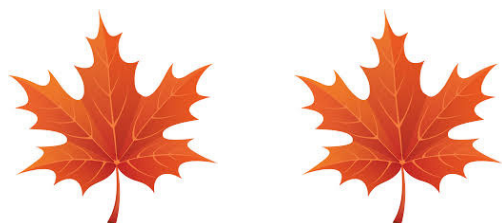
Spiky Hedgehog



This cheeky chap is made by dipping the end of a fork into brown paint and pressing down on the hedgehog's body. Alternatively, you could just put the end of the fork into the paint and drag it outwards on the page to make the spikes. There is a hedgehog template with these sheets you can use.



This is made by using leaves for the spikes! You can have fun collecting autumn leaves of all colours and shapes and sticking them on.

Snowy Owl

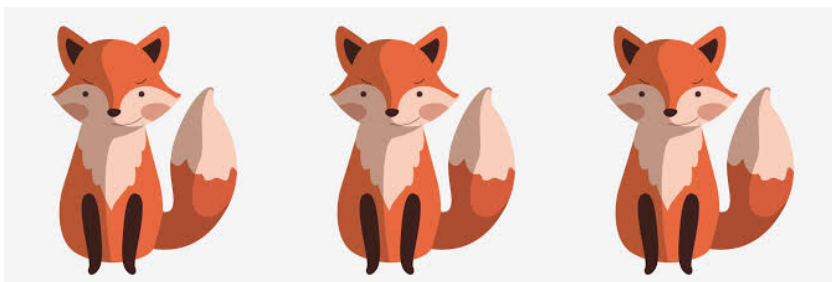


Use a bath sponge puff to get this lovely, soft effect of fluffy feathers. Dip it into white paint and press down onto black paper or card. You can stick on cut out eyes – make sure they're huge! – and a beak. The branch can be cut from brown paper or you could scrunch it up before sticking it down for a more 3-D effect. Beautiful!



The good old paper plate is used here! Cut a section for the face shape. Then decorate it with orange paper, or maybe print it with orange paint. Then cut triangles for the ears, a lovely black nose and some funny eyes. Sticking them close together makes him look extra cute!
