The sun is out and it's time to celebrate how lovely it is! Try some of these sun-themed crafts...



This is made by drawing around little hands on yellow paper – they can then be rolled and unrolled so that when they are attached behind a paper plate they make pretty 3-D sun rays!

These fabulous suns are monoprints. A baking sheet makes an ideal base, or an upturned cake tin. Paint on a circle in washable paint and then use cotton buds or any other “pen” to draw in the paint. Press a sheet of paper firmly over the paper and lift off carefully – and there you have it! A beautiful shining sun print. The same paint can be spread out again and re-used to create another design!

You could make a 3-D sun – stick anything yellow, orange or red onto a large circle! Add wool, paint, pasta shapes and imagine what the surface of the sun could be like...



Alternatively, you could just completely go mad with orange, red, pink, yellow and gold paints on a black background for a truly spectacular fireball sun! Stick down a circle shape and then spread the beautiful, hot colours out from the centre with brushes, fingers, or the edge of a piece of card for a sensory experience with the energy of the sun!
