There are rainbows in many windows at the moment to show our support for our amazing NHS workers. Here are some ideas of different ways of making a rainbow to display in YOUR window!



Collage – tissue paper has been used here, but any paper could be used. The colours don't even have to be in different arcs to give the impression of a rainbow (rainbow template is attached)

Paint – add blobs of paint onto a piece of paper, put inside a freezer bag and seal it and then let your little one press and squash the paint to their heart's content! Make sure all blobs are squashed out so that when you remove it from the bag it dries easily



Paper plate – this makes a great template for a rainbow when cut in half. Cotton wool clouds at the ends of the rainbow are a lovely touch
